

TAARC Roundtable Net Script

[Text italicized in [Brackets] is Instructional and is not to be read over the air]

CQ, CQ, CQ. Calling ALL Amateur Radio operators. This is Call Sign with the Tarleton Area Amateur Radio Club Net. My name is Your Name Here and I will be your Net Control Station this evening.

This net is presented by the Tarleton Area ARC and meets on Tuesday evenings at 2000 local time, except for the first Tuesday of each month when we have our monthly club meeting.

All licensed amateur radio operators are welcome to join this session of the Tarleton Area Amateur Radio Club Net and we also welcome all those who are listening this evening on scanners.

This evening's net will be a roundtable net. During check-in, make a note of who checks in after you, and then when you're through talking you can just turn it over to them. If you can't remember, or if the line-up changes during the net, just turn it back to me and I'll hand it off to the next in line.

This is Call Sign, Net Control, with the TAARC Net.

[Remember to ID your station and the Net at regular intervals]

Are there any stations at this time with Emergency or Priority traffic? Please check in now.

[Handle IMMEDIATELY] [Recognize any calling stations and handle requests]

Are there any stations on backup or emergency power or any mobiles that may be leaving the coverage area of the repeater soon? Please come now.

[Record their call and handle their traffic immediately]

This is Call Sign, Net Control, with the TAARC Net. I'll open the Net now for general check-ins. Stations with Emergency or Priority traffic at any time during this net may break in by saying, "Break, Break." Will the first four stations please check in now.

[You can call as many stations as you want for the check-in rounds, don't forget to call for check-ins when you get to the end of the list]

[Sometime during the course of the net, handle these 'housekeeping' duties]

The Tarleton Area Amateur Radio Club holds its meetings on the first Tuesday of each month at 1900 local time. The meetings are held the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) at the Erath County Sheriff's Office. The SO is located at 1043 Glen Rose Highway, Highway 67, in Stephenville. Parking is in the lot on the west side of the building. Talk-in is on the 147 dot 360 MHz repeater. Meetings are open to anyone interested and VE testing is offered after each meeting. Walk-ins are always welcome.
